STEP 1

GET ADMITTED

- Option #2- High school ID AND USA Birth Certificate .

COMPLETE COLLEGE ADMISSIONS and PLACEMENT REQUIREMENTS

To meet college admissions, please complete one of the following:

- Junior or Senior with a GPA over 2.6, no placement is needed. Student will be admitted with their GPA
- Junior or Senior with a GPA below 2.6, or a freshman or sophomore, you must take the College Reading placement exam.

If you would like to take Math or English courses, please complete one of the following placement requirements:

- Junior or Senior with a GPA over 2.6 - no placement needed. Student will place with their GPA
- Junior or Senior with a GPA below 2.6, or a freshman or sophomore, you must take the College Algebra and/or College English Placement exams.
